raised with and accompanied by statements or ev	vidence sufficient to afford this body, and the parties to this
hearing, an adequate opportunity to respond to e	each issue.

that are in attendance; followed by the applicant	and all of those who are in support of the application. All of
those opposed to the application will then be allo	wed to speak, followed by those with general comments
who are neither for nor against the application. F	inally, the applicant will be entitled to a rebuttal period.
Please state your name, physical address, and ma	iling address clearly for the record <u>before</u> your comments.
Please try to avoid repetition if someone else has	already expressed the same thoughts. It is perfectly alright
to state that you agree with the statements of that	at previous speaker. Please be assured that everyone will
have an opportunity to speak.

placed in the record of this proceeding. To do that, either before or after you speak; please submit the

material to Vickie Nogle who will make sure your evidence is property taken care of.
