ORDINANCE NO. 347-2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.10.160 OF THE HUBBARD MUNICIPAL CODE TO PERMIT POLICE CHIEF APPROVAL OF REQUESTS FOR TEMPORARY BLOCKING OR CLOSING OF CITY STREETS

Findings

- A. The Hubbard Municipal Code vests authority in the City Council to approve requests for the temporary closing or blocking of City streets; and
- B. On occasion a request to temporarily block or close a City street must be reviewed and approved or denied between Council meetings; and
- C. To provide flexibility in such situations, the Council desires to delegate authority to the Police Chief or the Chief's designee to approve or deny requests for the temporary blocking or closing of City streets.

BASED ON THE FINDINGS, THE CITY OR HUBBARD ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 10.10.160 of the Hubbard Municipal Code is amended as follows (additions in *underlined italics* and deletions in strikethrough fonts):

10.10.060 Additional Authority of Police Chief Public danger.

- (1) Under conditions constituting a danger to the public, the police chief or his the chief's designee may install temporary traffic control devices deemed by him the chief or the chief's designee to be necessary.
- (2) Notwithstanding any powers granted to the council by the provisions of this chapter, the police chief or the chief's designee may approve or deny any request for the temporary blocking or closing of streets if, in the opinion of the chief or the chief's designee, a decision on any such request must be made before the next regularly scheduled council meeting.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty days from its adoption.
