The City of Hubbard is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Utility Worker I Part Time. The position, under the lead of the Public Works Superintendent, is a limited duration position of approximately 5-months, 25-hours per week. The weekly work schedule has some flexibility built in and will be discussed with the successful candidate.

REQUIREMENTS: Graduation from high school or equivalent and valid driver's license.

Duties are limited to mowing of public grounds to include city parks, railroad right-of-way, other city-owned property and routine maintenance and care of mowing equipment.

The successful candidate will exhibit a professional attitude, demonstrate the ability to take direction from a superior, enjoy working with the public and take pride in their work.

VETERANS' PREFERENCE: Veterans who meet the minimum qualifications for a position open for recruitment may be eligible for preference in employment under Oregon law. If you are a Qualified Veteran or Qualified Disabled Veteran and would like to be granted preference in the selection and hiring process for a specific posted job, please indicated that on your application and provide proof of eligibility by submitting a copy of form DD-214 or 215. The application must indicate you are claiming Veteran's Preference and the required supporting documentation must be submitted with your application.
