Public Works Superintendent - \$64,920 – \$78,960 Annually - The Hubbard Public Works Department is currently recruiting for a Public Works Superintendent. The Public Works Superintendent reports directly to the City Council and is responsible for overall leadership and management of the public works department, including the wastewater treatment plant, water treatment plant, streets, and parks. The City of Hubbard operates on a FY 2018-2019 Budget of \$8.3 million. The following is a list of required education and experience; High school diploma or GED certificate; and Wastewater Treatment Grade Level III Certification; Wastewater Collections Grade Level II Certification; Water Treatment I Certification; Water Distribution II Certification; Water Treatment I Certification; Water Distribution II Certification; CPR/1st Aid Certification or certification within twelve months of hire; and Six (6) years of increasingly responsible experience in Public Works or related field; or any equivalent combination of education and experience which provides the knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the essential functions and responsibilities of the position as listed in the job description. Candidates must possess a valid Oregon driver license and acceptable driving record; and reside within thirty (30) minutes response time on the basis of availability for on-call and/or emergency services. Preferred Qualifications are an Associate's or Bachelor's Degree in Public Administration, Emergency Management, Water/Wastewater Technician or related field desirable; Project Engineer or specialized training; Certified Pool and Spa Operator; Certified Public Applicator License for Pesticides; Cross Connection Specialist; Bilingual Spanish/English.
