MARION COUNTY OUTDOOR BURNING BAN EXTENDED

The Marion County Fire Defense Board has extended the ban on outdoor burning until at least October 15th. The continued restrictions have been prompted by dry warm weather and light east winds that are forecast for the coming week. Restrictions on outdoor cooking and warming fires have been lifted. Please see the attached announcement for more info.

Wildfire Update

The wildfires in Oregon's north and central Cascades that reached conflagration status during the Labor Day wind and thunderstorm are being monitored closely. These fires will continue to burn inside of their current footprint but are not expected to grow outside of the western containment lines as a result of the weather forecast.

Wildfire Evacuation Zones

Beachie Creek Fire - Over the weekend, Level 3 evacuation notices were lifted along Hwy 22 to Detroit. Much of the area within the fire footprints of the Beachie Creek and Riverside fires remain in Level 3 status and Highway 22 east of Detroit remains closed while crews remove rock slides and thousands of damaged trees along the roadway.

Riverside Fire – As of Tuesday September 29, all evacuation orders for Clackamas County have been lifted.
